

NAE CHICKEN TABLE AND METHODOLOGY NOTICE

Revised December 8, 2022



Urner Barry is a leading source for price reporting in the chicken sector. We are continuously soliciting feedback from stakeholders to ensure that our coverage reflects current trading conditions and practices. On October 31st, 2022, Urner Barry proposed changes to its chicken market coverage and sought industry feedback on those proposed changes. The comment period has now closed. To improve market transparency and provide stakeholders with meaningful information, Urner Barry will make the following improvements to its chicken market coverage:

1. An addition of a semi-weekly quotation to reflect market and transactional data for No-Antibiotic-Ever (NAE) chicken. This quote will be published on Tuesdays and Thursdays on a separate table alongside the daily conventional market report.
