The following quotations and regional data sets will be DISCONTINUED:

All Young Tom and Young Hen Frozen Whole Turkey East, Midwest, and West LTL Ranges	The five quotations, as well as the two regional data sets and LTL ranges referenced, have failed to meet the key submitter dependency standards set forth under Urner Barry's turkey methodology. Due to the lack of consistent spot trade being reported, they will be discontinued.
All domestic quotations under the "Midwest" and "West" regions	
Hen Drums, Domestic and Export	
Hen Whole Wings, Domestic and Export	
Hen Two Joint Wings, Domestic and Export	
Hen Necks, Domestic and Export	
Frozen Export, Drumettes	

Following the review period, the Urner Barry Turkey Market Methodologies document will be updated to include the changes.
